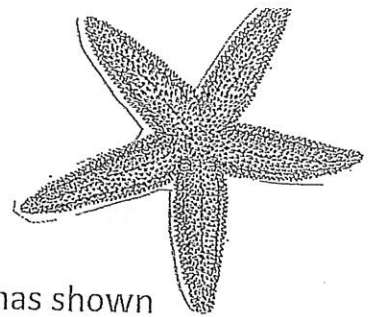


PBES Summer Reading List
